The PIEDMONT region in northwestern Italy produces several varietals and styles. Barolo and Barbaresco are made from Nebbiolo but have very different qualities. While Barolo is a big tannic expression of the grape, Barbaresco has softer tannins and can be enjoyed in its youth. Dolcetto produces a dry red wine with the same tannins while Barbera is often fruity and elegant.

TUSCANY, in central Italy, is the prime area for Sangiovese. Brunello di Montalcino is made from a clone of Sangiovese that has a fleshy texture, high acidity, smooth tannins and dark fruit flavors. Chianti is a wine primarily made from the Sangiovese grape that shows medium-high acidity and medium tannins with juicy red fruit notes.

The TRE VENEZIE is the Northeastern area that includes Veneto, Friuli-Venezia Giulia and Trentino-Alto Adige/Sudtirolo. Wines from these areas show a freshness, crisp acidity and a purity of varietal character. Amarone and Ripasso wines are full bodied and made with rich grapes to give rich, intense dark fruit notes and are high in alcohol.
